



Starting from June 2009 diagram was modified due to expansion of scope of data providers. In the case of VoCATV the new data providers increased the number of voice channels by 34,000.





Definition of terms used in the report:

Number of PSTN voice channels: The number of connections suitable for voice transmission at the end of the examined period, linking the subscriber access points with the remote subsciber stages or local exchanges. The number of connected voice channels includes lines implemented with radio devices as well as with copper or optical fiber cable; the number of ISDN main lines converted to (given in) "B" channels; and lines used for service provision at public payphones. The data excludes links realized in the frame of location independent electronic communications service, mobile telephone service and voice transmission via cable television networks and IP based networks. As for ISDN access basic rate and primary rate access is taken into account with two and thirty voice channels, respectively. [number]

Number of VoIP voice channels: number of voice channels implemented on broadband (xDSL, fiber) networks. Subscriptions using IP based networks and possessing geographic number according to the Hungarian Plan for National Identifiers should be considered. [number]

Number of VoCATV voice channels: number of voice channels implemented on cable television networks. [number]

Total number of connected voice channels: the aggregate number of PSTN, VoIP, and VoCATV voice channels. [number]

Number of originated calls: Total number of calls - irrespective of calling purpose (e.g.: Internet, speech, other, etc.) originated by the subscribers of the service provider in the given month. Traffic generated with carrier selection is also shown here. [number]

Duration of originated calls: Total duration of calls - irrespective of calling purpose (for example: Internet, speech, other, etc.) - originated by the subscribers of the service provider in the given month. Traffic generated with carrier selection is also shown here. [minute]

Number of residential voice channels: Based on the records (registration) of the service provider the number of voice channels where the subscriber is a natural person. [number]

Number of customers using carrier selection: Number of active customers making use of carrier preselection and call by call carrier selection. Customers who have used some type of carrier selection minimum once in the given month are to be considered as active ones. [number]

Duration of calls handled via carrier selection: Total duration of calls originated via carrier preselection or call by call carrier selection in the given month. [minute]

xDSL: Technology applied on local loops, making metallic twisted wire pairs constructed as part of the traditional fixed telephone network suitable for high speed digital data transmission. In the current domestic service offer, xDSL practically means ADSL (ADSL stands for Asymmetric Digital Suscriber Line). In the name the adjective "asymmetric" refers to a characteristic of the service according to which higher transmission rate is provided in download than in upload direction. [piece]

Cable modem: a modem, connected to CATV network, which is able to originate and receive digital signals within CATV network. Number of subscriptions using cable modem includes the number of subscriptions provided via LAN networks. [piece]

Geographic numbers: numbers used for fix telefon service. [piece]

The definition of market measure is based on expert estimation that refers to the NCAH's other data collections and market research information concerning the whole market.
